Facility:

The Red Land High School Natatorium is a six (6) lane, 25 yard pool. An automated Colorado timing system with a six (6) lane scoreboard display will be used. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used for the meet. Assigned team areas will be provided in the adjacent adaptive gym. Spectator seating is available in the bleachers located in the balcony area above the pool. A full concession area with seating will be provided outside the spectator seating.

**Officials
and
Timers**

Each team is asked to provide a list of officials and volunteers who may be contacted to volunteer for the meet. Officials and timers will receive free admission to the meet. Officials and timers will meet at 8:30am.

Eligibility:

This meet will be governed by the current 2011-2012 Federation Rules. All Events will be timed finals. There will be one (1) false start rule for all 8 & under events. It will be the coaches' responsibility to get their swimmers to the seeding area prior to the start of each event. Coaches' packets will be provided the day of the meet at the admission table. No scratch meeting – “positive check in for the 500 Yard free” (ages 12 and over minimum age requirement for 500 Yd free).

Entry Limits:

Swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) events. The 500 free does not count towards this maximum. The meet directors reserve the right to limit entries in any event to keep the meet timeline within a reasonable limit. If limits become necessary, teams will be notified through their coach/team rep. contacts. In the event limits are imposed, Swimmers whose events are cancelled will receive a full refund for those events. The last event of the meet will be an open, coed 200 free relay. Registration for this final event is not required.

Warm-ups:

7:00am --8:45 am

Warm-up schedules will be posted on the ACWS website (www.seaserpents.org) and distributed via email to league reps five (5) days prior to the meet and will be published in the meet program and coaches' packets the day of the meet. Sprint/Start lanes will be available during the final 10 minutes of each warm-up session. The referee reserves the right to remove anyone from the warm-up session for failure to comply with the warm-up standards.

How to Enter:

All events will be pre-seeded, timed final events. The meet will be swum in short course yards. All entries must be the swimmer's best time in each event. Any swimmers entered in an event with no time (NT) will be seeded last. Entries should be submitted using the Hy-Tek file formats. The entry file for the meet is available at www.seaserpents.org.

A hard copy printout of each entered swimmer listed alphabetically, with their events and entry times must be included with their entry fees and received by the club hosts within five (5) days of the entry deadline.

If you email your entries, please include a “Team Entries” and “Team Entry Fees” Word doc or pdf file from your Team Manager software.

All emailed entries will receive a confirmation email within 24 hours. If a Hy-Tek file is not possible, you may enter using the attached entry form.

Deck Entries: Subject to availability and at the discretion of the Meet Directors, deck entries will be accepted on the day of the meet with a fee of \$6.00 per event. Deck entries will only be accepted until 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet (8:30am). Deck entered swimmers will not be eligible for awards but their times will be official. Deck entered swimmers will be seeded last based upon the space available in the event entered. To enter, please see a Meet Director before 8:30am and all deck entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received by **SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5th, 2011.**
Hard copies of your entry and payment must be received within five (5) days of receipt of your emailed entries.

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Awards: 1st --8th place: custom ribbons

The team with the highest point will receive an engraved plaque, which will be used annually, listing the winning team each year.

Admission: \$3.00 per person (children under the age of 12 admitted at no charge)

Programs: Meet Programs will be available for \$3.00. Highlighters will be sold for \$1.00.

Results: Results throughout the meet will be posted in the hallway between the pool and gymnasium. Final meet results will be posted in printable HTML format and coaches' Team Manager CL2 files on www.seaserpents.org and www.swimcpal.org.

Deck Access: Deck access for the meet beyond the seating area will be limited to swimmers, coaches, officials, and meet volunteers. Coaches and volunteers must wear the provided ID tags to access the deck.

Spectators: Bleacher seating will be provided for spectators in the balcony area above the deck.

Concessions: An assortment of food and beverage items will be available throughout the meet located outside the spectator seating area. Seating will be available as well. Coolers will NOT be permitted in the gym. An area will be designated for coolers to be stored.

Hospitality: Complimentary food and drinks will be available for coaches and officials.

Parking: Free parking is available.

Swim Apparel: A vendor will be present at the invitational.

Web Site: All pre and post meet information, including entry packets, teams attending, warm-up times/lanes, psych sheets, results, and meet updates will be available on www.seaserpents.org.

BullPen Seeding: Event numbers will be posted and announced in the gym. Swimmers are responsible for reporting to the seeding area (auxilliary gym) when their event is announced and posted on the board. Any swimmer who can not be found will be scratched from the event. All swimmers must report to the clerk before they are seeded in their heats and lanes. Swimmers will be escorted to the pool and provided a basket in which to place their belongings while they swim. Please remind your swimmer to pick up his/her belongings from the basket at the conclusion of his/her race.

Take 83 South to Old Exit 16 (Fishing Creek Exit)
Make a right at the stop light onto 262 West
Continue on 262 West for ½ a mile to Red Land High School on left

FROM CHAMBERSBURG AND EAST:
Take I-81 North
Take PA-581 East exit and merge onto 581-East
Continue on 581-East to I-83 South (York)
Take I-83 South to Old Exit 16 (Fishing Creek Exit)
Make a right at the stop light onto 262 West
Continue on 262 West for ½ mile to Red Land High School on left

FROM KUTZTOWN AND NORTH:
Take I-81 South
to I-83 South (York)
Take 83 South to Old Exit 16 (Fishing Creek Exit)
Make a right at stop light onto 262 West
Continue on 262 West for ½ mile to Red Land High School on left

*****Entrance to the pool is through the LAST set of doors on the right as you travel along the driveway entrance in front of the school. Swimmers can be dropped off at the pool entrance location--parking is available in the lower lots below the driveway entrance.***
