

Spectators are reminded of the following rules for viewing at Cumberland Valley High School. Please note that the meets hosts have been notified by the school district that failure of spectators to follow these rules (in particular no food or drink other than water in the gallery) may result in a fine being levied to the final bill from the district. We ask for your cooperation.

**SPECTATOR SEATING:** The spectator seating area is limited to 375 spectators by order of the fire marshal and CV school district. In order for all families to have a positive experience, we will again utilize the wristband system for gallery seating. Swimmers will be housed in the cafeteria. In the event the spectator area becomes overcrowded, we reserve the right to restrict access to this area. Thank you for your understanding. Other CV school district gallery spectator restrictions:

- \* **No food or drink (except water)**
- \* **No large bags, backpacks, blankets, etc.**
- \* **No reserving, marking, saving seats**
- \* **No blocking of designated walkways and stairs**
