

Officials: On deck officials, please wear white tops and navy bottoms and have applicable official's patch

visible. Officials will need to check-in prior to the start of the meet to get their deck badge.

Coaches: Only four coaches per team will be permitted on deck at any one time

Awards: First through twelve for individual events; first through six for relays

Coaches or Team Reps are required to pick up awards at the end of the meet. Awards will not

be given to swimmers or parents.

Refreshments: The concession stand will be located down the hallway, past the entrance to the pool area. It will

provide a variety of food, snacks and beverages throughout the entire meet.

Hospitality: The Coaches and Officials hospitality area will be located in the girls' pool office which is in the

corner opposite the gallery at the shallow end of the pool.

Supervision/Team

Area:

Each team will have a designated area in the school gymnasium. The Palmyra High School and the Palmyra Aquatic Club requires that each team provide adult supervision in their team area and

comply with the Palmyra High School regulations. Anyone found defacing the property, not abiding by school regulations, and/or displaying unsportsmanlike conduct will be asked to leave the

premises.

Spectator Seating: The spectator seating area is limited 300 spectators. In order for all families to have a positive

experience, we will ask that spectators leave the spectator seating area after watching their swimmer
